Richier Ligier (1503-1567) was a French sculptor and architect. He is known for his religious sculptures, including the Crucifixion in the choir of the church of Saint-Étienne in Troyes. The Crucifixion is a large wooden sculpture, 150 cm high, depicting Christ on the cross, flanked by the two thieves. The figures are carved with a high degree of realism, showing the physical suffering of the subjects. The sculpture is set against a background of stone and stained glass windows. The Crucifixion is a masterpiece of French Renaissance sculpture, and it is one of the most important works of Ligier Richier.
